Home Again Program



- Registers a Dementia Patient
- Photographs
- Address information
- Provides needed help in the event a senior wanders.



Care Track System



- Aids in Seniors with Alzheimer's who wander
- Provides Tracking equipment for location assistance in the event of an emergency.
- There is a suggested donation



Senior Citizen Law Enforcement Academy

- Provides education in law enforcement & public safety
- Monday April 16-20 classes start at 1:00pm to 5:00pm daily
- Topics covered: uniformed patrol, jail/custody procedures, gang investigations, identity theft.

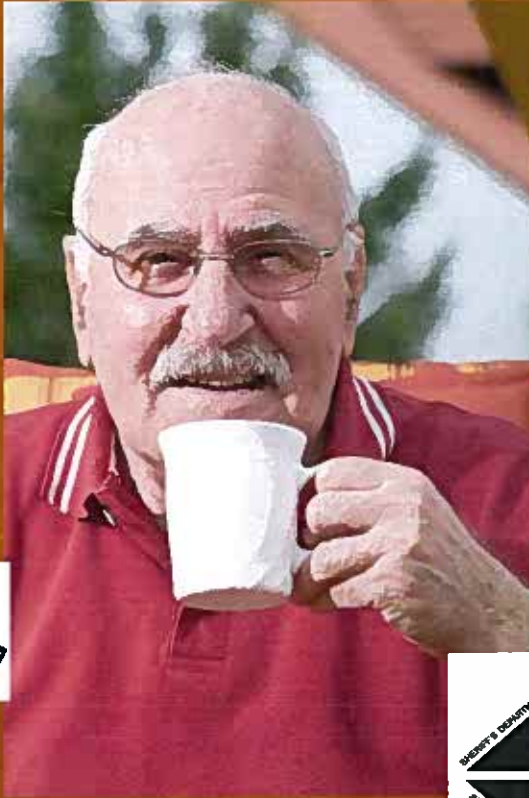


The Guardian System Program

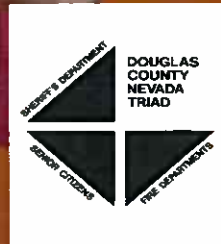


- Utilizes Computerized telephone system to call seniors daily

- Seniors on Meals on Wheels receive educational handouts and crossword puzzles addressing like senior fraud.



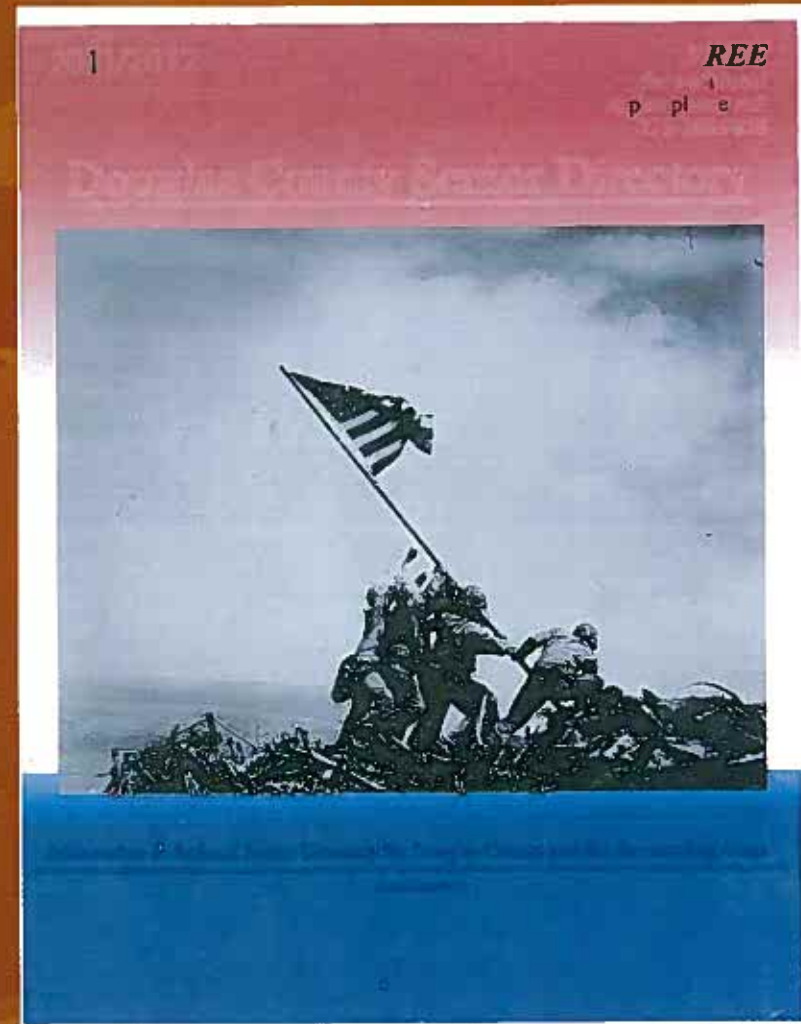
Senior I.C.E. Program

- Fund Raising project



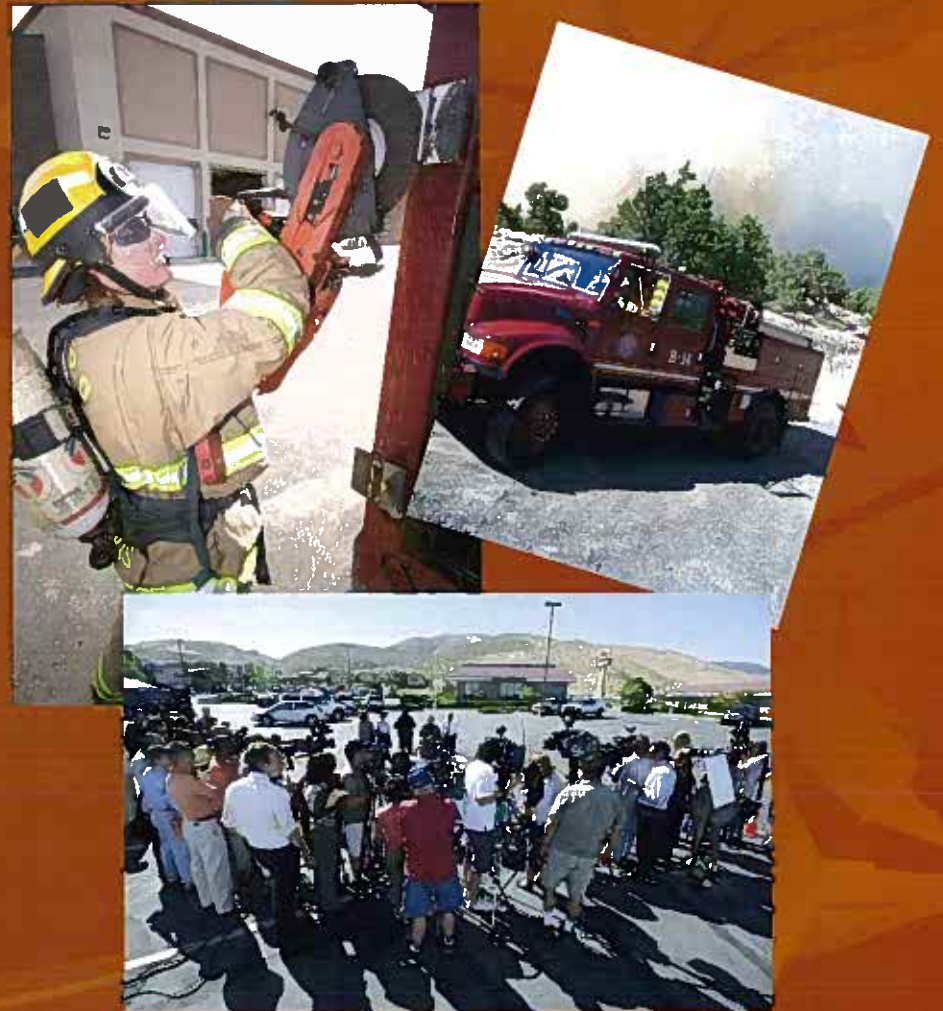

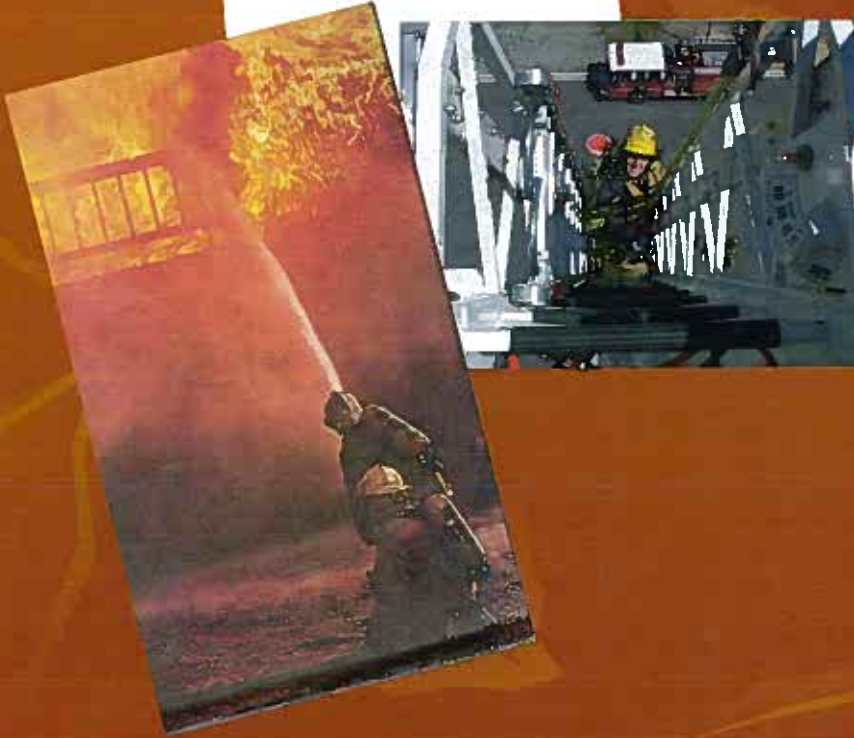

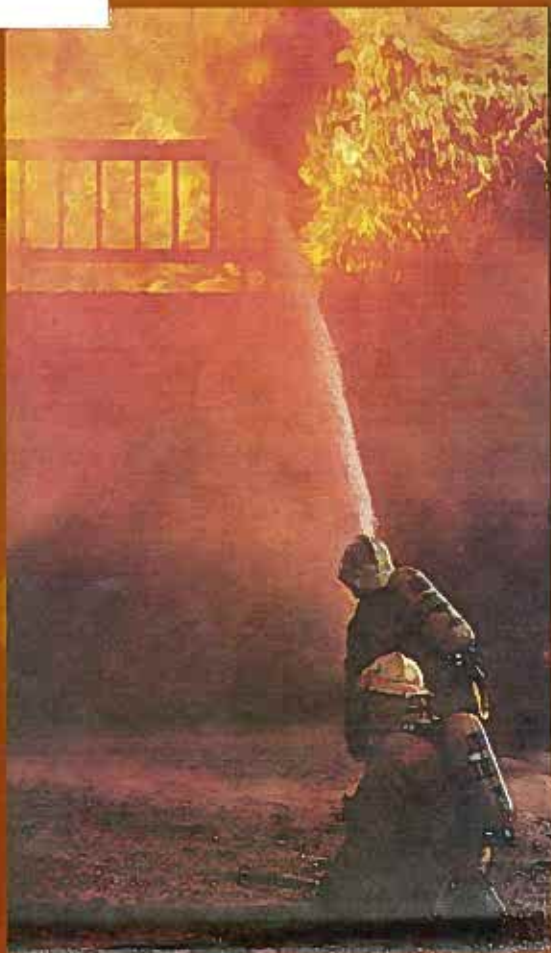
