WHO ARE THE FRIENDS?

The Friends of the Douglas County Public Library is a Nevada nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting, contributing to, and promoting the Douglas County Public Library. Our membership includes students, teachers, parents, grandparents, business leaders, community leaders, and interested citizens. A Board of Directors is elected annually from the membership, by the membership, and serves a one-year term.

MEMBERSHIP

When you join the Friends, you support a valuable community resource—the Douglas County Public Library. Donations to the Friends, a qualified 501(c)(3) organization under IRS regulations, may be tax deductible as allowable by law. Contact your tax advisor for advice concerning the deductibility of your membership donation.

Your membership entitles you to attend the Friends-Only preview sale before the library's Spring and Fall book sales, giving you first choice on sale items. Also, you receive a 10% discount during the book sales when you show your membership card.

The Friends of the Douglas County Public Library Board of Directors meets at 4 p.m. the 2nd Monday of every month in the Minden Library meeting room. Members of the Friends are always welcome to attend.

WHAT DO THE FRIENDS DO?

The Douglas County Public Library serves a growing community. The library's annual operating budget is negotiated from limited funds each year, and is funded primarily by room tax and a dedicated sales tax.

The Friends of the Douglas County Public Library provides "no strings" funding for many special programs and projects that enrich, expand, and enhance what the library has to offer patrons of all ages. Many programs and projects promote literacy and learning, contributing to a strong community library.
